let it blurt is the raucous and righteous biography of lester bangs 1949 82 the gonzo journalist gutter poet and romantic visionary of rock criticism no writer on rock n roll ever lived harder or wrote better more passionately more compellingly more penetratingly he lived the rock n roll lifestyle guzzling booze and romilar like water matching its energy in prose that erupted from the pages of rolling stone creem and the village voice bangs agitated in the seventies for sounds that were harsher louder more electric and

more alive in the course of which he charted and defined the aesthetics of heavy metal and punk he was treated as a peer by such brash visionaries as lou reed patti smith richard hell captain beefheart the clash debbie harry and other luminaries let it blurt is a scrupulously researched account of lester bangs s fascinating if often tawdry and unappetizing life story as well as a window on rock criticism and rock culture in their most turbulent and creative years it includes a never before published piece by bangs the hilarious how to be a rock critic in which he reveals the secrets of his dubious freeloading trade
